




BATTERY REPLACEMENT INSTUCTION SHEET

Parts included:

2 ea 50Ah Battery






Note: place a rag between the mudguard and the seat rails

Required tools:

- 5mm hex key
- 2x 13mm socket wrench or wrench
- 4mm hex key
- 10mm socket wrench
- Torque wrench

A. Replacing the Batteries on a Q200R without Tilt

- Remove thumb screw (A) on both the left and right sides. Manually tilt the seat frame back. Place a cloth on top of the mudguard to protect the shroud and decal. (Fig 1)
- Remove front battery cover (B) by lifting up and forward on the front hand grip. Remove the back battery cover (C) by removing the 4 screws (D). (Fig 2)
- Disconnect the battery harnesses from the front and rear battery. Use the handles on the front battery (E) to lift and remove it from the battery box. (Fig 3)
- Remove the foam battery spacer (G) (Fig 5) and slide the rear battery (F) forward to remove. (Fig 4)
- Install the new rear battery (F). Refer to figure 5 for the correct battery post position. Re-install the foam battery spacer (G) as shown in figure 5. Install the new front battery (E). Refer to figure 5 for the correct battery post position.
- Re-install the battery harnesses. Refer to the battery schematic located inside of the battery shroud (C) removed in step 2.
- Re-install the battery cover (C) using the previous 4 screws (D). Torque to 4-6 Nm.
- Lower the seat and re-install the thumb screw (A) on both the left and right sides. (Fig 1)
