



## IRIS TRANSIT KIT

#### I. Parts included in this Transit Kit:

- a. 2x Rear Transit Loops
- b. 2x Front Transit Bracket
- c. 2x 5/16" Button Head (Rear)
- d. 2x 1/4-20 Button Head (Front)
- f. 4x Washer & 2x Wave Washer
- e. 2x Bushings and Washers (Rear) 2x 5/16" Nylock Nut (Rear)
- h. 2x I/4-20 Nylock Nut (Front)
- i. Ix Transit Strut (Fixed or Adj)

## 2. Tools needed:

- a. I/4" hex key
- b. 3/16" hex key
- c. I/2" open end wrench
- d. Torque Wrench with Standard hex bits.

### A. REAR TRANSIT BRACKET ASSEMBLY

NOTE - The occupant must be removed from the IRIS for this assembly.

# I. Remove the original Rear Strut

a. Using a 3/16" or 1/4" Hex key, remove the screws (A) holding the rearmost strut tube (B) to the rocker frame(C).

## 2. Place the new Transit Strut


a. Position the Transit Strut included in your kit and proceed to Step 3


# 3 Assemble the Rear Transit Brackets for a standard dual-post back

- a. Using the 3/16" hex key, assemble the parts as shown and thread the 5/16" button head screw (D) through the hardware and into the strut tube (B).
- b. Make sure the Wave Washer is in the correct location (G)

WARNING: take care with the Wave Washer (G) as it must be centered. You may apply two drops of contact adhesive in order to keep wave washer centered during assembly. Wait until dry, then assemble the bracket.

- c. Repeat this process for the opposite side of the chair.
- d. Tighten both button head screws holding the transit brackets (E) to the frame. Torque to 80 in-lb.








- a. Using the 3/16" hex key, assemble the parts as shown and thread the 5/16" button head screw through the hardware and and rocker (C) into the nylock nut (F).
- b. Make sure the Wave Washer is in the correct location (G)

WARNING: take care with the Wave Washer (G) as it must be centered. You may apply two drops of contact adhesive in order to keep waver washer centered during assembly. Wait until dry, then assemble the bracket.

- c. Repeat this process for the opposite side of the chair.
- d. Tighten the hardware using a 1/2" open wrench and 3/16" hex key. Torque to 80 in-lb. TORQUE



## B. FRONT TRANSIT BRACKET ASSEMBLY



- I. Assemble and Place the Front Transit Bracket
  - a. Place the front transit bracket (A) on the frame location (B) and insert the hex head screws(C) through the washers into the rocker frame.
  - b. Slide the washers (D) on the hex head screw and hand tighten the nylock
  - c. Finish by tightening the hex-head screws (C) to a maximum torque of about 120 in-lb.
  - d. Repeat this process for the other side of the wheelchair.



# C. TRANSIT STICKERS 5 6

- I. The placement of Transit hook location stickers is essential for the safety of the rider and compliance with WC-19 standards.
  - a. Peel the backing from the Front Transit Hook decals and place them on each side of the chair in the location shown in Figure 5.
  - b. Peel the backing from the Rear Transit Hook decals and place them on both sides of the chair in the location shown in Figure 6.
  - C. Peel the backing from the WC-19 Transit decals and place them on both sides of the chair in the location shown in Figure 6.




- I. Double-check Orientation and Torque on all Hardware.
  - a. Check that front and rear transit brackets have been installed evenly.
  - b. Using a torque wrench, check front and rear screws for correct torque.




