

QM7 PERFORMANCE SPRING INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please read these instructions carefully before beginning the installation. Failure to understand and follow installation instructions may result in injury to installer and/or end user and may void the warranty. If you have any questions call Sunrise Medical Technical support at 800-333-4000.

NOTE- Some parts are not shown in the drawings for clarity. 1. 2 ea Front shock 2. 4 ea M8 x 1.25 x 35 bolts A. PRE-INSTALLATION |1||2||33. 2 ea Nylock nut 1. Remove spring: a. Remove drive wheels (A). Set wheels and lug nuts (B) aside, Fig 1. b. Remove Nylock nut (D) from suspension spring (E) first, then remove M8 bolts (C), Fig 2. Discard hardware. Slide spring (E) down and out of spring mount, Fig 3. C. Discard spring. B. INSTALLING NEW PERFORMANCE SPRING 245 Note- If you are adding springs to a chair that does not already have them be sure to install springs on both sides. **Note-** Red spring is a standard spring. Black spring is a light spring. Ensure that your springs match. 1. Assembly of suspension spring: a. Insert the new spring up into spring mount. Note- Ensure that the serrated nut end is up, Fig 4. b. Install new bolts (C) into spring, then install nut (D) tighten bolts to 10 ft-lbs (13Nm), Fig 2. c. Screw down the serrated nut until there is no play in the 2 spring, Fig 4. d. If installing springs on a chair that did not already have springs: Screw down the serrated nut on the suspension shock (F) until approximatly 5/8" of thread is showing (1-1/8" from the top), Fig 5. Repeat on opposite side. e. Replace drive wheels, torque lug nuts to F 25 ft-lbs (33Nm). D C. INSPECT 1. Performance spring is oriented in the correct direction. 2. Suspension shock has been adjusted (if needed). 3. All hardware has the correct torque.
