
- 1.2 ea armrest link (A)
- 2. 4 ea retaining clip (B)
- 3. 1 ea threaded spindle (C)
- 4. 1 ea M6x10 SHCS (D)
- 5. 2 ea brass spacer (E)
- 6. 1 ea washer (F)
- 7. 2 ea Phillips head screw (G)
- 8. 1 ea right-hand shroud (H)

Required tools:

- 1.5mm hex key
- 2. Phillips screwdriver
- 3. Torque wrench

With Armrest-See Sections A-C


Without Armrest-See Sections D-E





A. With armrest: installing armrest link


1. Unfold the backrest, and raise the armrest in order to install the armrest link (A) with the bushing facing toward the pins as shown in figure 1.

2. Install the retaining clips (B) onto the pins as shown in figure 2 and 3.

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
B. Installing Backrest locking hardware (with armrests)


Note: items notated in parentheses are for reference.

- 1. Using a 5mm hex key, install the threaded spindle (C) and one of the brass spacers (E) through the (J) and (K) as shown in figure 4.
- 2. Using a 5mm hex key, install the last brass spacer (E), the washer (F), and the M6 SHCS (D) into the threaded spindle (C) as shown in figure 4. Using the torque wrench torque the M6 SHCS to 1.8 ft-lbs (2.5Nm).
- 3. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, install the Phillips head screws (G) and the right-hand shroud (H), as shown in figure 5. Using a torque wrench, torque the Phillips head screw to 2.2 ft-lbs (3.0Nm).

C. Inspect

- 1. Inspect to verify all torque specifications are met.
- 2. Verify that back anale adjustment functions properly. by adjusting the threaded spindle (C) with a 5mm hex key.
- 3. Verify the armrest recline up and then back down again.


- 1.1 ea M6x30 SHCS (L)
- 2. 1 ea spacer (M)
- 3. 1 ea receiver nut (N)

Required tools:

- 1.5mm hex key
- 2. Torque wrench


D. Installing Backrest locking hardware (without armrests) Note: items notated in parentheses are for reference.


- 1. Unfold the backrest, and align the mounting hole on the side of the frame, shown in figure 6.
- 2. Using a 5mm hex key, install the M6x30 SHCS (L), spacer (M), and receiver nut (N) through the mounting hole, as shown in figure 6.
- 3. Using a torque wrench, torque the M6x30 SHCS (L) to





E. Inspect
