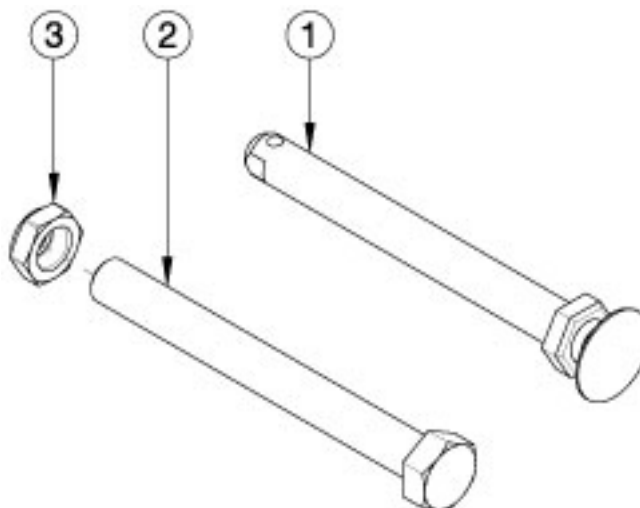

MAXX Mag wheels and Attendant Foot Lock and/or T-Arms <u>ARE</u> Present	102371

## **CR45 Axles and Receivers**

To find the appropriate axle, first establish the axle receiver according to the RECEIVERS section and then determine the axle using the AXLES section.

### **RECEIVERS**

Receiver: 112500

Description: Axle Plate, Weldment

Used When: Always

Receiver: 112501

Description: Threaded Axle Receiver

Used When: Fixed Axles are present

### **AXLES**

Quick Release Axles:

Use 101191 when 12" and 16" Mag wheels and Push/Pull to Lock wheel locks ARE present

Use 101191 when MAXX Mag wheels and Attendant Foot Lock and/or T-Arms ARE NOT present

Use 102371 when 12" and 16" Mag wheels and Attendant Foot Lock ARE present

Use 102371 when X Core Mag wheels ARE present

Use 102371 when MAXX Mag wheels and Attendant Foot Lock and/or T-Arms ARE present

Fixed Axles:

Use 102086 with ALL wheels

# Quick Release Axle Measuring Guide

**To identify which axle you have:** Set your axle on the printed copy of this page (do not scale when printing) or take the measurement as shown and locate which overall dimension matches that of the axle you have.

**Note:** The overall length is not the same as the “useable length” which is the length used in the part description. Images of all axles are shown below.
