

SECTION 1: WITH ARMRESTS





Sedeo Pro Semi Recline Gas Spring with Armrest Assembly Parts (Section 1):


- 1.2 ea armrest link (A)
- 2. 4 ea retaining clip (B)
- 3. 2 ea M4x10 SHCS Screw (C)
- 4. 2 ea Internally Threaded Bolt (D)
- 5. 2 ea Washer (E)
- 6. 4 ea Phillips Head Screw (F)
- 7. 1 ea Left Corner Shroud (G)
- 8. 1 ea Right Corner Shroud (H)


A. With armrest: installing armrest link


- 1. Unfold the backrest, and raise the armrest in order to install the armrest link (A) with the bushing facing toward the pins as shown in figure 1.
- 2. Install the retaining clips (B) onto the pins as shown in Figure 2 and 3.
- 3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to the opposite side of the chair.


Required tools:

- 1.3mm hex key
- 2. Phillips screwdriver
- 3. 13mm crescent wrench
- 4. Torque wrench





B. With Armrest: Installing Backrest Link

- 1. Insert Internally Threaded Bolt (D) through the Backrest Link and the seat, as shown in Figure 4.
- 2. Using a 3mm hex key, install M4 screw (C) through washer (E) and thread into Internally Threaded Bolt (D), as shown in Figure 4. Using the torque wrench, torque the M4 SHCS to 2.0 ft-lbs (2.7Nm)
- **3.** Repeat steps 1 and 2 to the opposite side of the chair.
- 4. Insert Phillips Head screws (F) through the chair as shown in Figure 5. Thread into Left Corner Shroud (G). Using a torque wrench, torque the Phillips Head screws to 2.2 ft-lbs (3.0Nm).
- 5. Repeat Step 4 to the opposite side of the chair using Right Corner Shroud (H).

C. Inspect



- 1. Inspect to verify all torque specifications are met.
- Verify the armrest recline up and then back down again.

SECTION 2: WITHOUT ARMRESTS

Perform the install outlined in Section B using the Hardware C-H.

1. Inspect to verify all torque specifications are met.
