
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
- A. Replacing the Batteries on a Q200R with Tilt
 - Remove Bolt (A), Washer and Nut (B) on both the left and right sides. (Fig 1)
 - 2. Remove Bolt (C) and Nut (D) from tilt actuator. (Fig 2) Note: extending the tilt will help with accessing the bolts.
 - 3. Manually tilt the seat frame back. Place a cloth on top of the mudguard to protect the shroud and decal. Pull the seat forward on the rear slide block (F) until it reaches the rear mount stopping pin (E) as shown in figure 3.






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- A. Replacing the Batteries on a Q200R with Tilt (continued)
 - 4. Remove front battery cover (I) by lifting up and forward on the front hand grip. Remove the back battery cover (H) by removing the 4 screws (G). (Fig 4) Note: retracting the tilt actuator will help with removing the battery cover.
 - 5. Disconnect the battery harnesses from the front and rear battery. Use the handles on the front battery (H) to lift it out of the battery box. (Fig 5)
 - Unplug actuator harness from controller or ism. The controller is located behind the rear shroud (L). To remove the rear shroud and access the controller, remove 4 screws (M) shown in figure 6B. The ism (N) is mounted on the front battery with adhesive hook and loop (P and O) shown in figure 6C. Remove the 6 bolts and nuts (K) shown in Figure 6A to remove the tilt actuator and lower mount.
 Slide the rear battery (Q) forward to remove. (Fig 7)
 - Install the new rear battery (Q). Refer to figure 8 for the correct battery post position. Re-install the lower tilt mount, torque all 6 screws (K) to 2-4 Nm as shown in Figure 5. Re-route the actuator harness to the proper module.
 - 9. Install the new front battery (J). Refer to figure 8 for the correct battery post position.
 - 10. Re-install the battery harnesses. Refer to the battery schematic located inside of the battery shroud (H) removed in step 4. Re-route and connect the actuator harness.
 - 11. For chairs with an ism, install new adhesive hook and loop (P and O) provided between the front battery and ism module as shown in figure 6C.
 - 2. For chairs without an ism, re-install the rear shroud (L) after re-connecting the actuator. Torque all 4 screws to 4-6 Nm.
 - 13. Re-install the battery cover (H) using the previous 4 screws (G). Torque to 4-6 Nm. (Fig 4)
 - Lower the seat and re-install the bolt (C) and nut (D) to the tilt actuator. Torque to 4-5 Nm. (Fig 2)
 Re-install Bolt (A), Washer and Nut (B) on both the left and right sides as shown in figure 1. Torque to 6-8 Nm.
 - 5. Slide the front battery cover (G) back, and push down on the front hand grip to latch. (Fig 4)
