

## Q300M SUSPENSION SPRING REPLACEMENT

### Suspension spring kit (two kits required):

- FRONT SHOCK (spring) (x1)
- HHCS M6x12 (x2)
- M6 FLAT WASHER (x2) 3.
- 4. HHCS M12x88 (x1)
- M12 FLAT WASHER (x1)
- CASTER ARM ROLLER (x1)
- 5 mL of Loctite 243 (x1)
- \* SHCS M8x16 (x3)
- \*M8 LARGE FLAT WASHER (x3)

#### Required tools:

- 6mm hex key
- 2. Torque wrench
- 3. 13mm crescent wrench
- 4. Socket wrench: 10mm, 16mm, and 18mm
- Linear measuring instrument with a resolution of 1mm

## Note: Some parts are not shown in drawings for clarity.

\* included in kit, not needed for this replacement

## A. PRE-INSTALLATION 123


- Remove spring:
  - Using 16mm socket wrench, remove drive wheel (A). Set wheel and lug nuts (B) aside.
  - Using 10mm socket wrench, remove the motor and motor mount by removing the bolt (C) and washer (D).
  - Next, remove bolts (E and G) to remove the spring (I). Using 10mm socket wrench, remove bolt E and washer (F). Using a 18mm socket wrench, remove bolt (G), washer (H), and roller (I). Then, remove spring (J).
  - Complete same steps on opposite side of chair.


# B. INSTALLING NEW SUSPENSION SPRING 12345


- Complete section A steps 1a through 1d in reverse, using new spring and hardware from kit.
  - Screw down the serrated nut on the suspension spring (J). Spring should be compressed to 120 +/-1mm. (Fig 4 and Fig 5)
  - Attach new spring to the mounting holes using new roller (I), new washers (F and H), and new bolts (E and G). Apply two drops of Loctite 243 to the threads of bolt E and torque to 30 Nm +/- 10% [22.13 ft-lbs +/- 10%]. Apply two drops of Loctite 243 to the threads of bolt G and torque to 50 Nm +/- 10% [36.88 ft-lbs +/- 10%]. Note: Ensure that the serrated nut end is up. (Fig 4)
  - Attach the motor and motor mount using new bolt (C) and washer (D).
  - Replace drive wheel (A). Torque lug nuts (B) to 33.9 Nm [25 ft-lbs +2/-0].
  - Complete same steps on opposite side of chair.


## C. INSPECT


- Suspension spring is oriented in the correct direction.
- All hardware has the correct torque.
