

RECLINE BACKREST INSTALLATION



Please read these instructions carefully before beginning the installation. Failure to understand and follow installation instructions may result in injury to installer and/or end user and may void the warranty. If you have any questions call Sunrise Medical Technical Support at 800-333-4000.

1. Ergo Recline Back

Tools needed for assembly:

- 3, 4, & 5mm Hex key
- Torque wrench
- 3. 10mm Socket/open wrench
- 4. 13mm Socket/open wrench
- 5. Wire cutter (for cutting cable-ties)

Note- Some parts are not shown in the drawings for clarity.

A. REMOVAL 1

- 1. Follow instruction sheet for CxSM replacement (248017) to remove the CxSM and the distribution block.
- 2. Remove the potentiometer by removing screws (A) and its harness from the CxSM, also remove the recline actuator harness. (Use 5mm hex key) Save hardware.
- 3. Set the potentiometer, CxSM, and distribution block with harnesses aside.
- 4. Remove all of the armrest pads, joystick mounts, and harnesses until it looks like the seat in Figure 1. Note locations.
- 5. Remove all of the hardware and links that connect the recline back to the seat on both sides (hardware B, C, D, and E). (Use 4 & 5mm hex key, 10 & 13mm wrench)
- 6. Remove the recline back. Save all hardware.

B. INSTALLATION 1

- 1. Align the holes of the recline back with the shift pieces as shown in Figure 1. Insert item B to hold the recline back in place, then attach the links with hardware C, D, and E. (Use 4 & 5mm hex key, 10 & 13mm wrench)
 - Torque B, C, & D to 120-132 in-lbs (13.6-14.9Nm). Torque E to 60-70 in-lbs (6.8-7.9Nm).



- 2. Put the armrest pads, joystick mounts, and harnesses back in the same locations they were in. (Use 5mm hex key)
- 3. Line-up the potentiometer with the bracket and mount it with screws (A). (Use 5mm hex key) Torque to 60-70 in-lbs (6.8-7.9Nm).
- 4. Follow instruction sheet 248017 to put the CxSM back together with the distribution block.

C. INSPECT

- 1. Recline seat to ensure all wire harnesses are out of the way and are not getting pinched.
- 2. Recline seat to verify that the harnesses are not put under tension in any position.
- 3. Ensure that the cable-ties are not so tight that they deform cable jackets.
- 4. Where possible cables should be protected and hidden by shrouds.
- 5. Use torque wrench to check torque values.
